AID Atlanta

AID Atlanta has been saving and transforming lives since its inception in 1982, driven by the mission of reducing new HIV infections and improving the quality of life of our members and the community by breaking barriers and building community. Embracing the core values of compassion, respect, service excellence, and integrity, AID Atlanta quickly expanded to offer a broad range of services to meet the needs of the community and has since grown to be one of the most comprehensive HIV service organizations in the Southeast.

AID Atlanta's service delivery model has evolved to offer a full continuum of care including medical case management, housing assistance, and emotional wellness care. Through our affiliation with AIDS Healthcare Foundation, AID Atlanta has been able to provide primary HIV medical care and on-site pharmaceutical services.

AID Atlanta works to prevent new HIV infections through education, free HIV/STI screening and treatment, PrEP services, community outreach programs, and operation of the Georgia HIV/STI information line.

40 Years of Hope

AID Atlanta's 40th Anniversary Celebration is an opportunity for our community to celebrate 40 years of success, evolution, and steadfast service as we commemorate those who have been impacted by HIV/AIDS and recognize those who have joined us on this journey to end the HIV epidemic. While our mission and core values guide our programs and services, it is through the combined efforts of our incredibly dedicated staff, passionate volunteers, and loyal supporters that we have been able to save and transform thousands of lives since 1982. This event will provide a full evening of delicious lite bites, adult beverages, entertainment, and speakers.

Anniversary Celebration Guests

Our guests will represent the full spectrum of diversity, as we will be inviting all community stakeholders to join us in celebration. This will include highly respected members of the HIV/AIDS field and the nonprofit sector including the AID Atlanta Board of Directors, Atlanta Advisory Board, and colleagues from HIV/AIDS Service Organizations, along with representatives of other nonprofits.

Additionally, AID Atlanta is an organization that highly values diversity at every level, evident by the fact that our staff, from leadership to professional entry-level staff members, predominantly identify as Black/African American, Indigenous, Persons of Color (BIPOC) and Female. While the more than 60,000 service encounters in Greater Atlanta represent diverse ethnicities, genders, sexual orientations, sexual identities, abilities, and socio-economic status. On average, the clients we serve identify as Black/African American, Cis Male, between the ages of 24 and 55 years old. These men reside in Fulton, DeKalb, or Cobb counties, earn less than \$33,000 annual income, and are uninsured or underinsured.

We are planning on welcoming a substantial number of former and current clients of AID Atlanta, as well as current and former staff, to the event. Historically, the HIV epidemic disproportionately affected Men who have sex with Men, and still disproportionately affects Black Men and Latino Men. LGBTQ+ private sector individuals, organizations, and corporate partners are the backbone of financial support for AID Atlanta with tens of millions of dollars raised and donated over our 40-year history.
